The Vision


On my first visit to Haiti in 2003, I visited villages in Balan, Savane Cabrit and L'Etant. What I saw broke my heart so badly it literally ached. My life changed forever as I confronted poverty at its worst: children sick and dying from disease, their bellies swollen from malnutrition and parasites; many without clothes and shoes; lack of safe drinking water, food, and medical aid; and beautiful but desperate little faces that still haunt me. God spoke to my heart and gave me a vision to help them; thus was born Rescue Children.

Initial and immediate emphasis will be placed on saving children's lives and improving their health by providing clean drinking water, food, nourishment, clothing, housing, and medical assistance. As we minister, we will share the love of Jesus.

Long-term plans include a main complex with a clinic, orphanage, school, storage facilities, feeding station, food distribution and warehouse center. A satellite feeding station, food distribution center and well will be constructed in each village.

- Poorest country in Western Hemisphere.
- Predominant religion is voodoo.
- UN calls Haiti a "silent emergency," noting its vital statistics rival sub-Saharan Africa.
- Ranks last on International Water Poverty Index.
- Has third-highest rate of hunger in world.
- Located only 700 miles SE of Miami, FL.
- Most densely populated and lowest per capita income country in our hemisphere.
- Annual wage for most Haitians <US\$500.
- Highest per-capita AIDS death rate in the hemisphere and one of highest in world.
